



EVENT RULES & GUIDELINES

All participants engaged in any functions or activities at any of the organizations events and/or property of the event, are expected to conduct themselves in ways that reflect positively on themselves as well as on the organization.

I. SPONSORS: Each church/mission needs to have two present Adult Sponsors at the event site. A qualifying sponsor may be a Youth Leader, who be accountable for his/her Youth when addressing participant behavioral concerns. Adult Sponsor are at least 25 years of age, and is designated by their local church. Additionally, Youth under the age of 18 years require a Parent/Guardian's signature on their Registration Form.

II. ELECTRONICS: One of our goals at LBY's Christian camps/retreats are to help participants experience a new/renewed spiritual revival within themselves or come to know Christ. In keeping with this goal—individuals causing disruption or preventing the equal opportunity for other campers to participate will be addressed immediately. This includes the use of any and all stereos (mp3 players, car stereos, phones, etc), portable TVs, electronic games, and the like. Photo cameras are allowed. Adult Sponsors should be aware and ensure their participants are within these guidelines.

III. PARTICIPATION: By attending an LBY event, you are consenting to actively participate in all scheduled activities including classes, games, and worship services. This also means during scheduled events, an individual should NOT be anywhere else (namely, cabins/dorms). An Officer should first be given consideration for any approved exceptions.

IV. CABINS: Participant cabins are predetermined at the Registration table and grouped by gender. Males and females are prohibited from entering or loitering around each others cabin/dorm area. Cabin/dorm areas and their surroundings are off limits to all non-residents.

V. CLEAN-UP: During meal times, please clean up after yourself and wipe down your area. Volunteers to sweep and wipe down tables are appreciated. When departing, each participant is responsible for maintaining and cleaning their cabins/dorms. A nice gesture would be to extend your clean-up efforts to your respective Brothers and Sisters as well.

VI. VANDALISM: Any vandalism and property damages are grounds for dismissal from all future LBY events and the individual will be responsible for recovering any monetary damages.

VII. DRUGS: Any item, substance, or matter that may cause harm to others or themselves are prohibited. Such items are inclusive to weapons, drugs, and alcohol.

Failure by any individual to adhere to these expectation may prohibit the individual's participation from future LBY events. Not only are some of these prohibited items/actions illegal (VI & VII), but may also result in consequences involving local law enforcement.

DRESS CODE

Please exercise good judgment and modesty at all times and refrain from wearing articles of clothing with inappropriate/disturbing graphics/messages.

- **MALES:** Should always have on a shirt, unless you are in the pool. (Not on your way to the pool)
- **FEMALES:** Shorts, skirts, and dresses should be no shorter than 3" above the knee. (As a rule, your index and middle finger together is approximately one inch long in width)
- **SWIMMING:** Men should have wear appropriate swim trunks. Females have the option of a one-piece bathing suit or a "non-see-through" shirt and shorts.
